WHEREAS,

The Partners concluded and signed a Consortium Agreement with the Effective Date of 1st April 2013 ("Consortium Agreement"), in order to specify or supplement binding commitments among themselves in addition to the provisions of the Grant Agreement Nr: 314632 of the European Union.

WHEREAS.

The Partners submitted a Contract Amendment (Amendment No.1 to Grant Agreement) that has been approved by The European Commision on 20th April 2015 and the changes included in the Amendment No.1 to Grant Agreement affect some articles of the Consortium Agreement.

THEREFORE the Partners agree to the following:

SECTION 1: The Consortium Agreement is amended as follows:

Replacement of Articles 6.1, 7.1 (specifically 7.1.1), 7.3 and Annex 6 of the Agreement by the following new provisions:

ARTICLE 6. MANAGEMENT STRUCTURE AND DECISION PROCEDURES

6.1 PROJECT MANAGEMENT STRUCTURE

(I) PROJECT COORDINATOR:

Third bullet point is stated as follows:

The coordinator, as chairman of the Project Management Board, will call for face to face project management meetings every 12 months (kick off meeting in month 1 and months 12, 24, 36, 48, 60 and 72) and at any moment if indispensable.

(iii) PROJECT MANAGEMENT BOARD

Fourth bullet point is stated as follows:

Meetings: CENER, as chairman, shall convene meetings of the Project Management Board. It will meet seven times during the project (month 1, month12, month 24, month 36, month 48, month 60 and month 72) and at any extraordinary moment if indispensable. Each Partner shall be present or represented at any meeting; may appoint a substitute or a proxy to attend and vote at any meeting; and shall participate in a cooperative manner in the meetings.

(iv) PROJECT TECHNICAL COMMITTEE:

Third bullet point is stated as follows:

Meetings: BOKU, as chairman, shall convene meetings of the Project Technical Committee. It will meet every 6 months (kick off meeting in month 1 and months 6, 12, 18, 24, 30, 36, 42, 48, 54, 60, 66 and the final meeting in month 72) during the project. Any extraordinary meetings will be convened if indispensable. Each member shall be present or represented at any meeting; may appoint a substitute or a proxy to attend and vote at any meeting; and shall participate in a cooperative manner in the meetings.

(v) PILOT TEAMS AND LEADERS

First bullet point is stated as follows:

The project will implement 6 pilot districts and 3 associated cities in a total of 9 geographical areas in 9 countries. Additionally each pilot will be locally implemented and each implementation will have a responsible partner. The following table shows the pilot leaders and participants:

7.3 PAYMENTS

Forth and Fifth bullet point are stated as follows:

- Funding of costs included in the Consortium Plan will be paid to Partners after receipt from the EU-Commission in separate instalments. The Partners agree on the following instalment mechanism:
 - o For those partners whose Requested EU contribution is lower than 1.000.000 €, they shall receive the 100% of the pre-financing once the Coordinator has received it.

 For those partners whose Requested EU contribution is higher than 1.000.000 €, the pre-financing shall be paid as follow:
 - The first payment of the Community financial contribution to the Partners shall be 50% of the pre-financing.
 - The second payment of the Community financial contribution to the Partners shall be paid according to the workload and deliverables declared by the Partners.
- Subsequent payments to the Partners will be done after the reporting periods of month 18, month 36, month 54 and month 72 respectively, according to the workload and deliverables foreseen for the Partners and provided that the coordinator had received the corresponding EC contribution after those periods.
- Any exception to the instalment mechanism will be discussed and evaluated by the Project Management Board.
